

## TOWN OF EDEN FIREWORKS DISPLAY APPLICATION

In accordance with Section 405.00 of the New York State Penal Law, applicants must provide the following information before a permit for the public display of fireworks will be issued:

**Note:** The cost of the permit is \$50.00. A detailed drawing or diagram of the grounds on which the display is to be held should be attached to the permit request. Such drawing shall show the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged, the location of all buildings, highways, and other lines of communication, the lines behind which the audience will be restrained and the location of all nearby trees, telegraph or telephone lines or other overhead obstructions.

## REQUIREMENTS

If granted, this permit will be subject to the following provisions:

1. The actual point at which the fireworks are to be fired shall be at least two hundred (200) feet from the nearest permanent building, public highway, or railroad, or other means of travel and at least fifty (50) feet from the nearest aboveground telephone or telegraph line, tree, or other overhead obstruction.
2. The audience at such display shall be restrained behind lines at least one hundred fifty (150) feet from the point at which the fireworks are discharged and only persons in actual charge of the display shall be allowed inside those lines.
3. All fireworks that fire a projectile shall be so set up that the projectile will go into the air as nearly as possible in a vertical direction.
4. Any fireworks which remain unfired after the display concludes shall be disposed of in a way safe for the particular type of fireworks remaining.
5. No fireworks display shall be held during any windstorm in which the wind reaches a velocity of more than twenty (20) miles per hour nor during an extreme dry weather period.
6. All the persons in actual charge of firing the fireworks shall be over the age of eighteen years, competent, and physically fit for the task and **must provide proof** that the person in charge is a State Certified Pyrotech.
7. There shall be at least two such State certified operators constantly on duty during the discharge.
8. At least two Class A rated or other approved fire extinguisher shall be kept at as widely separated points as possible within the actual area of the display.
9. No permit granted and issued hereunder shall be transferable.
10. After a permit has been granted, sales, possession, use and distribution of fireworks for such display shall be lawful solely therefore.
11. A bond, as required by Section 400.00(4) of the Penal Law, shall be in the amount of \$1 million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) or in lieu of such bond, the applicant may submit a liability insurance policy covering the applicant, sponsor, fireworks discharging persons or contractor, and the Town of Eden for limits not less than \$1 million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) each occurrence. Such liability insurance shall agree to indemnify the persons insured for all damages and injuries which may be caused to a person or persons or to property by reason of the display so permitted and arising from any acts of the permittee, his agents, employees, contractors, or subcontractors.
12. The applicant shall submit the original bond or a true and complete copy of the liability insurance policy, except that an original Certificate of Liability Insurance may be submitted, provided it contains an agreement to notify the Town of Eden in the event of cancellation of such insurance before the display event and it includes the Town of Eden as an Insured. Any cancellation of the Bond or Liability Insurance Policy, whether or not known to the Town of Eden, shall be an automatic and simultaneous cancellation of the permit.
