



TOWN OF EDEN RECYCLING AND REFUSE GUIDELINES

Dear Town of Eden Residents.

Effective January 1st, 2012, a new contract went into effect with Waste Management for collection and hauling of the Town's solid waste and recycling. Waste Management is extremely pleased to be the new provider for the Town, and hope the information below will help make the transition a smooth one.

Solid Waste

You can place up to 3 bags or containers of solid waste per week. Trash cans must be of standard size with original handles. Drums and barrels are unacceptable. You may also purchase up to five additional bags from the Town, bringing your maximum per week to eight bags. Garbage shall be placed within 5 feet of the curb or roadside by 6:30A.M. on your collection day. A maximum of 65 pounds or 40 gallons is allowable for each bag or container.

Yard Waste, Bulky Waste, Construction & Demolition (C&D) Material and White Goods (Appliances)

The maximum allowed per week for each stop shall be: (1) white good and (1) container or bundle of yard waste, C & D or bulky waste. *White goods will be collected separately from your household waste and/or recycling.* Please follow the simple guidelines below to ensure collection occurs:

- ✓ Yard Waste must be bagged or containerized and not weigh in excess of 65 pounds or may be bundled and tied in 4ft lengths or less and no more than 4 inches in diameter.
- ✓ Plasterboard, scrap wood etc must also be less than 4 foot in length and not to exceed 60 pounds and must be bundled or containerized.
- ✓ Carpeting must be rolled in 4 foot or less lengths and taped securely. Rolls should not exceed 60 pounds.
- ✓ Bulk items such as chairs/couches should be placed at the curb. Limit one per week and will be included as your weekly allowance.
- ✓ Christmas trees will only be collected during or after the holiday season
- ✓ No contractor materials will be collected.
- ✓ Only water based/latex paint can be collected. Paint must be thoroughly dry. Kitty litter or sawdust can be used to accomplish this. Leave at the curb with the lids off.

Recycling

Please refer to the attached recycling guidelines. If in doubt, feel free to contact our customer service department at (800) 333-6590. Recycling does not need to be separated and will be collected as single stream. Please be sure all cardboard is no bigger than 2' x 2'.

Electronic Waste

In accordance with the disposal ban requirements of Section 27-2611 of the Electronic Equipment Recycling and Reuse Act, on **January 1st, 2015**, it became unlawful for residential households in New York State to place electronic equipment at the curb for disposal. **Due to this change in law, Waste Management no longer collects electronic waste at the curb – even if segregated from the rest of the household trash.** Consumers should visit the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation's website at <http://www.dec.ny.gov/chemical/66872.html>, for a full list of the types of electronic equipment covered by this law and to learn how they may properly manage their electronic waste in an environmentally responsible manner.
