March Program – On March 16 at 2:00 P.M. at the Eden Library you can learn details about **the sinking of the passenger ship Lusitania**. Linda Ulrich-Hagner, a Trustee of the Aurora Historical Society and a Docent at the Roycroft Inn and Campus will be presenting this program. On May 7, 1915 the Lusitania was struck and sunk by a single torpedo from a German submarine and sank in less than 20 minutes off the coast of Ireland. Many Americans were killed including Elbert and Alice Hubbard and Albert Vanderbuilt. Much controversy still remains about how the politics of the United States, England, and Germany contributed to this tragedy.
